2005 KOENIGSEGG VELT.1 (GV)

It's hard to imagine Austrian wine labels getting simpler than this - the potentially intimidating grape variety doesn't even appear on the front label, replaced by the shorter, hipper V E L T . 1. And while the wine inside might not be the most complex GV you'll ever sample, it's light, clean and fresh, with gingery, spicy nuances to pear and apple flavours. Probably best as an aperitif, but it has enough intensity to match scallops or shrimp dishes. - www.velt1.com
